Venue Manager Role– Message from Revd. Nick

“As you will know, we have been really pleased to see the number of community groups using our new flexible space. The responsibility for preparing the space and hosting those groups has fallen on the shoulders of a few, dedicated volunteers. Our church council has discussed this and recently agreed to the appointment of a paid venue manager who will work 25 hours a week to enable us to put our community venue on a more sustainable footing. There will, of course, still be the need for members of the church to play our role in preparing the space, particularly for worship and church events but it is hoped that by appointing a venue manager we will ease the burden on key individuals so that we can all enjoy this space as a creative place for worship, mission and for the enrichment of our wider community. Should you know of anyone who may be interested in the role, details can be found on our website. Please hold this process in your prayers, as this is an important appointment for the realisation of our reordering vision.”

John 18. 33-37

Then Pilate entered the headquarters again, summoned Jesus, and asked him, 'Are you the King of the Jews?' Jesus answered, 'Do you ask this on your own, or did others tell you about me?' Pilate replied, 'I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests have handed you over to me. What have you done?' Jesus answered, 'My kingdom is not from this world. If my kingdom were from this world, my followers would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not from here.' Pilate asked him, 'So you are a king?'
